## DOWNINGTOWN

Is one of the oldest settlements of Chester county and many of the present residents are descendants of the pioneers who engaged in the struggles attending its development and progress. In 1859 it was incorporated, with an area of about 760 acres. Its location is admirable, being in the heart of the famous Chester Valley, upon the historic Brandywine creek and protected on either side by the north and south valley hills. Its railroad connections include the Pennsylvania Central (main line), Philadelphia and Reading (Chester Valley branch), and the Downingtown and Lancaster Railroads. These great traffic ways afford unlimited shipping facilities in every direction, to all parts of the country at the lowest competing freight rates. Philadelphia is but 32 miles distant and there are trains almost hourly to and from that point.
